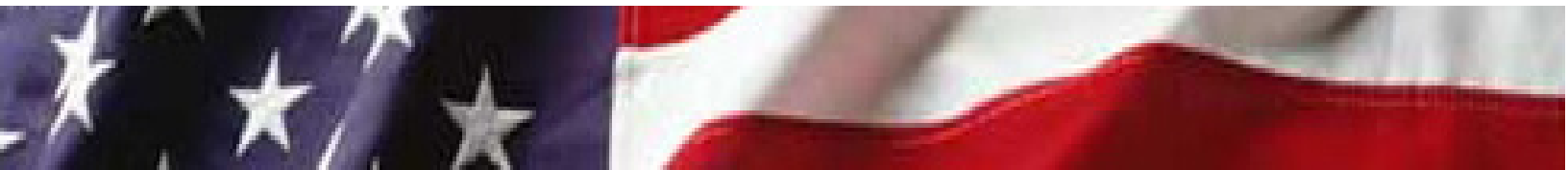

## Let the Department of Veteran Affairs help pay for Assisted Living!

*The Department of Veteran Affairs offers a special benefit to war era veterans and their surviving spouses called Aid and Attendance.*

Springhouse is offering a free benefits analysis to our residents and potential qualifying residents. This is a tax-free benefit designed to provide financial assistance to help cover the cost of an assisted living facility. This benefit is for those veterans and surviving spouses who require the regular attendance of another person or caregiver in at least two of the daily activities of living such as transportation, dressing, undressing, bathing, cooking, eating, grooming, personal hygiene needs, homemaking and maintenance.

If you or your loved one served honorable military service of at least 90 days with one day during a period of war, you or your loved one may be eligible for the following:

- A veteran with a spouse may qualify for as much as \$2,019 per month
- A single veteran may qualify for as much as \$1,703 per month
- A well veteran-ill spouse may qualify for as much as \$1,336 per month
- A surviving spouse may qualify for as much as \$1,094 per month

Springhouse is happy to announce a new relationship with a local consulting firm that will expedite the application process and provide guidance on how to access this veteran benefit. This service is free to those who are living at or plan to move to Springhouse.
